- **Responsible Cycle Riding** This is a fundamental key to the success of the eBike scheme and the cycling through St Peters Street. All users of shared spaces need to be aware of each other, whether it is car drivers, cyclists or pedestrians. Promotional material has been prepared by **TR**, however it was thought that endorsement by a major stake holder is also required (eg council, police, etc..) to help convey the message.
