

Derby Air Quality Plan - where's the cycling?

- Review of draft proposals & response*
- 2. Response to detailed proposal no cycling!
 - we added cycling w/o affecting plans for motor traffic except...
 - our demand to retain Friar Gate cycle facilities (our one and only demand)
 - council added cycle lanes @ Stafford St roundabout & provided good Brick Street crossing
- Stripping Away Our Safety: semi naked protest*
- 4. Objection to Business Case*: retain or improve FG cycle lane:
 - Council & DEFRA
- Council ignore consultation responses supporting cycling:
 - 61.2% (4th highest) thought switching to lower emissions transport modes (such as cycling) can improve air quality
 - the top 3 suggestions for how to tackle air quality issues included "more cycle lanes or an improved cycling infrastructure".
 - 44% (4th highest) supported greater use of active travel investment and promotion
 - 31.7% of respondents (4th highest) use a bicycle as part of their current transport menu
 - 36.1% of respondents (4th highest) said they would consider using a bicycle more to help improve air quality
 - The most common "other comment" (17) called for increased cycling infrastructure
