## 7. Events Diary

## 8. Campaigns & Strategy

- **Off-peak cycling through city centre.**  
Derby City Council are proposing to allow cycling along the pedestrianised areas of St Peters Street & Cornmarket between 5pm and 10am.  
Some form of (common sense) education may be required to ease this introduction to ensure polite & courteous behaviour between cyclist & pedestrians.  
Any planning application to be supported by DCG.
- **Connected Cycle City** - Western Corridor.  
Derby City Council are proposing to introduce / improve the cycling infrastructure in the South/West side of the city. This is a large undertaking and the full status of any plans & applications need to be fully understood. An additional separate meeting(s) was proposed to focus on this topic.
- **Suggested Projects** - All members encouraged to suggest any potential improvements to the Derby cycling infrastructure via the DCG website <https://derbycyclinggroup.org.uk/blog/suggest-projects/>  
Such suggestions can then be used to potentially improve the Tube Map and help establish a strategic plan for the Derby City cycle infrastructure.
