

The **Derby Cycling Group** was formed in 1979 by a group concerned at the increasingly marginal role of cycling in the city's transportation system. Since then we have campaigned for the improvement of cycling conditions in Derby and for raising the public profile of cycling as an economical, ecological and healthy form of transport.

- We are heavily involved in transport consultation
- We liaise with the City Council, the County Council, and environmental and cycling organisations, both local and national
- We promote cycling at the city's festivals and other public events
- We help to organise cycle rides
- We've organised bike parks at public events such as the annual firework concert.

- Getting permission for cyclists to use the city's bus lanes
- Major influence on Derby becoming a Cycle Demonstration Town
- Creating the original cycle map
- Contributing to the cycle audit
- Review of cycle parking
- Key member of Derby Cycle Forum

- Organised CTC/CCN national conference in 2007
- Ensuring Derby Arena (Velodrome) project proceeded
- Cycle access to the city centre
- Opening of Deadman's Lane to provide access to Pride Park
- Cycling provision at the Railway Station
- Excellent cycling provision during building of new inner ring road
