## Contents:

- Two A4 ring-binder files. One contains the documents relating to the establishment of Sustainable Transport (Sustrans) as a company and includes its constitution, articles, minutes of meetings, directors' and auditors' reports, and such like documents. The second contains correspondence relating to the overall planning of the scheme, which involves converting disused railway lines into cycle paths.
- Six file wallets, which contain maps, plans, and slides of every portion of each section of the route. The six file wallets cover the Chesterfield, Mansfield via Worksop, Mansfield to Rainworth, Newark to Mansfield, Nottingham to Newark, and Staveley to Sutton-in Ashfield, sections of the route respectively.
- Twenty-three pocket wallets containing correspondence with the various Councils in the East Midlands, the Forestry Commission, Water Boards, Peak Park and British Rail (as it was then). There is also track research and urban research into the project.
