Derby COVID-19 Emergency Active Travel schemes

Tranche 1:

A number of temporary ‘pop-up’ schemes having been introduced after full funding of £228K was received.

The London Road scheme was introduced in mid-September. Although not ideal, it seems the best yet for cyclists & pedestrians.

Unfortunately, the lane introduced on Uttoxeter New Road was removed at the end of September. This is disappointing, especially as no notice of its removal was given or consulted. When removed the road was not swept or cleaned, thus leaving a more dangerous cycle lane. Comments have been made to the council, but no response received.

Tranche 2:

This is to consist of temporary/permanent proposals that require public support requiring funding of approx. £800K.

Specific plans have not been published. It is hoped they will be available soon. They are believed to be an extension of Tranche 1 and incorporate safe havens and quiet zones for schools, etc. (eg maybe twice a day)

Member are encouraged to contact the council with their opinions of the schemes so far.
