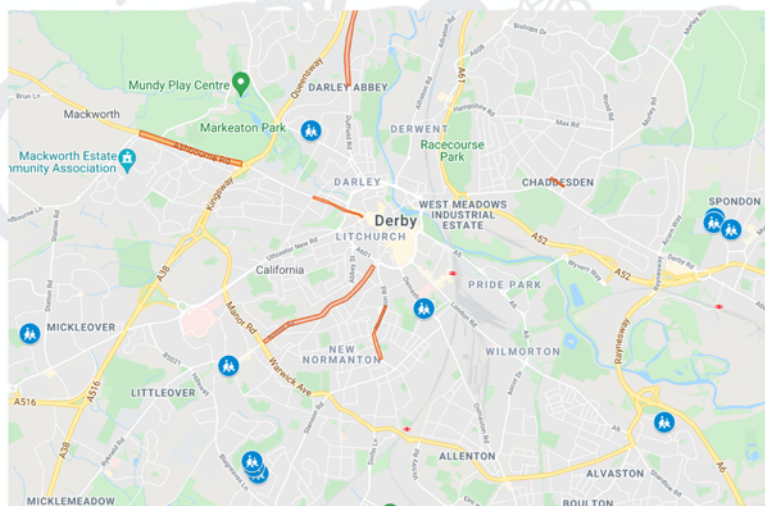

Active Travel Schemes : Tranche 2

- Reviews completed of Duffield Road, Burton Road, Sinfin Road and Palm Court Island roundabout.



- Additionally, the segregated cycle path on Broadway finishes abruptly just before the roundabout. There is space here to reconfigure the road to allow a cycle priority filter from the off-road cycle path on to the road. This could be achieved by creating a curve in the road approaching the roundabout using an artificial barrier, and moving the cycle lane exit onto Broadway slightly earlier, before the driveway to the school, the pub and the footpath.



Duffield Road, Green Street – Kedleston Road – Duffield Road at Five Lamps

- The advanced stop line at the Five Lamps junction on Green street is helpful in reminding cyclists to take primary position through the junction. To compliment this, installing "Do not overtake cyclist" signs at the traffic lights on Green Street (entry to West Avenue) and

I have taken a few photos of pinch points on Burton Road that I think would have to be addressed to make it safe for the average 12,500cc, or any less confident cyclist.

I started at the junction with Whitaker Road because that is where some motorists and cyclists join and is the start of traffic building up to get through the traffic lights at the Abbey Street junction. Further up Burton Road towards Littleover there is less congestion and cycling is arguably safer - until the traffic lights at the Warwick Avenue/Manor Road crossing.

Whitaker Road Junction:

This is also the end of the up-hill section of the on-road cycle lane climbing the hill out of Derby

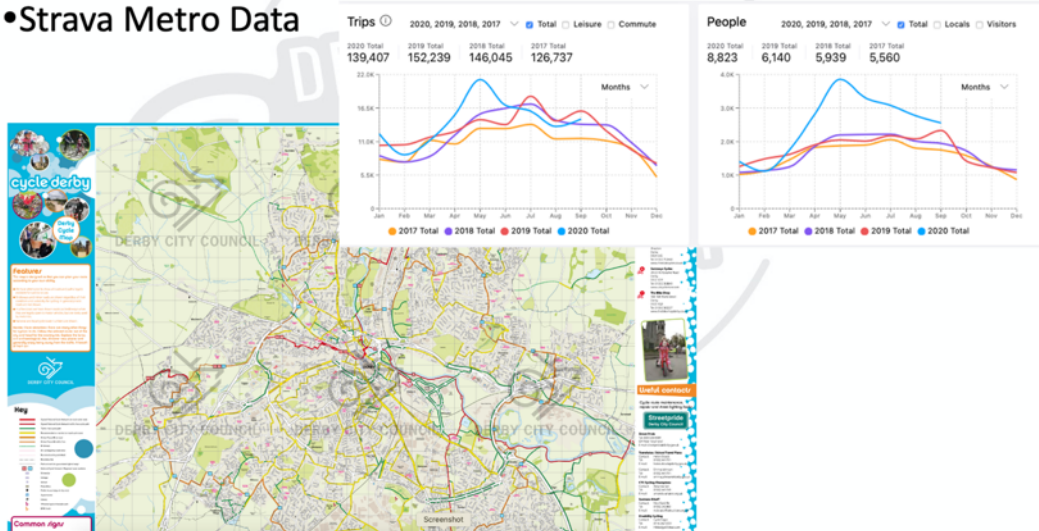
