






- Lifecycle closure and resurrection as Ay Up Bikes

Little Progress



- Allestree Park rewilding access to and through

- One last barrier on NCN (Paddock pub)
- Duffield Road school parki ng (9+ years!)
- Formal links with City Council



Cycling - needs to be safe, attractive and suitable for an unaccompanied 12 year old, connected to wider network

Bus users - need to be able to access the local bus stops Access needs to be in all directions - not just to/from Derby

- Issues outside the Park (and Derby City) can be addressed by solutions in the Park
- Reduce demand for in-Park car parking Encourage family cycling to and within the

What would help:

- Encourage joint Derby/Derbyshire working
- · Consider beyond Park area Encourage cross dept, working within LAs
- Call for Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan (LCWIP) to be revisited



To look forward to



- Little Eaton Greenway opening
- SmartParc link path
- A38 Junctions related work
- Trent River Bridge near Trent Lock (long term!)
- Derwent Valley Cycleway Belper, Ford Lane sections
- Mickleover estate NCN re-routing
- EMCCA leading to more joined up plans?
