## 2 Review of Infrastructure Improvement Ideas

Most of the meeting was taken up by a workshop to develop a prioritised list of infrastructure projects that we'd like to see in Derby and around as input to any future LCWIP process.

## 3 EMCCA Local Transport Plan

There is a consultation event for this in Derbion Shopping Centre on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> December from 3-6pm. Members of the EMCCA team will be there to discuss the plan although it is not clear whether they will be taking input. All DCG members encouraged to visit. **ID** will add an item to review the effectiveness of the consultation to next month's agenda.

## 4 Compassionate Derby Event

**TR** will run a Derby Cycling Group stand at this annual ethical living event at St Peter's Church Hall next Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> December and asked anyone who is free to join him there.

## 5 The Loop and the Mayor

Mayor of the East Midlands, Claire Ward, is walking 150 miles across the region, following a path she hopes to formalise as The Loop. This is billed as a route for both walking and cycling. **ID** asked for suggestions at the next meeting of where and how we might request to meet her in Derby in the near future in a way that would enable us to present the case for cycling.

## 7 Campaigns

### 7.1 Council EV charging and secure cycle parking

Council press release <https://www.derby.gov.uk/news/2025/october/sustainability-success-in-six-streets/> includes information on "secure cycle parking" as part of the "Mobility hubs" installed around Derby. **JB** to send out photos of the hubs and then organise a ride to view and assess how good the "secure cycle parking" is. **TR** to write to Council about shortcomings on the Six Streets parking.

### 7.2 Flood works

Some discussion on the suitability of diversions for cycles arising from the current flood works. **MA** to do on-the-ground survey and then follow up with the contractors if any shortcomings. Some diversions may only be suitable for pedestrians and not cycles.

### **7.3 NCN barrier near Paddock**

Just one A frame barrier remains on NCN in Derby area (other restrictions remain – e.g. steep slopes, narrow sections). ID has asked Derby City Council to remove the one final A frame barrier on the NCN.

The local Councillor (Councillor Hudson) supports the removal.

ID has chased the City Council for progress but has not received any reply (both in August and November). **ID** to continue to chase.

### **7.4 Allestree Park rewilding**

The new Hall owners have applied for planning permission to change use of the Hall to a wedding venue and hotel. As part of this application an inadequate “Travel Plan” was included purporting to show how staff would be able to reach the Hall via walking, cycling or buses.

Long term project being led by Pedals (Nottingham) but supported in principle by DCG. **JB** to review wealth of information that has been circulated.
